Dear Governor Haley,

Thank you for your continued leadership on behalf of our state's youngest learners. We are grateful for your support during FY17 of a number of significant priorities for the children and families we serve, including increased funding for First Steps' local partnerships and BabyNet. Attached, please find South Carolina First Steps' SFY 2017-18 state budget request. In addition to the enclosures, there are three items with which we request your assistance.

1. Provide 50% of the state funding in the form of State General Funds.

Due to delays in Education Improvement Act cash disbursements, First Steps continues to struggle during the first quarter of each fiscal year to pay for its ongoing costs. As a sales tax, these funds are accrued and disbursed by the state over the course of the year, with funds available at the first of the year statutorily committed to other organizations. At the time of this writing, nearly three months into the fiscal year, our regional finance managers are holding many local partnership payments due to lack of cash on hand. We are grateful for the support of our partners at the SC Department of Education, who work each year to help us mitigate this issue, but would appreciate your assistance in ensuring that at least a portion of First Steps' annual funding be derived from State General Funds.

2. Change our budget structure to one that more clearly depicts our programmatic efforts.

The following structure would be more transparent and allow for clearer accountability and understanding of our areas of expenditure.

- A. Policy and Accountability
- B. Private 4K
- C. Early Childhood Services
- D. Employee Benefits

3. BabyNet.

Proviso 1.74, SDE: First Steps Accountability, which was included in the SFY 2016-17 State Budget, requires us to report to you and members of the General Assembly by December of 2016, as to whether the additional funding for the BabyNet Program in the SFY 16-17 budget are sufficient to cover the cost of bringing the program into compliance. As part of our efforts to improve the BabyNet Program, we worked through a comprehensive process with a broad group of partners to evaluate the current structure of the program and identify the best ways to accomplish this task. One of the outcomes of this effort was a comprehensive, joint budget request designed to correct longstanding deficiencies in the program as transferred to us in 2010. This plan was forwarded to you in December of 2016.

Per Executive Order 2016-20, the lead agency responsibilities will be moved to the SC Department of Health and Human Services on July 1 of 2017. In consultation with Director Soura at DHHS, we are submitting the request we had already developed – as our recommendation for the system - with the understanding that he may choose to request modifications based on his identification of needs as the transition process plays out. As recommended by the Legislative Audit Council in 2011, we recommend that all BabyNet funds flow through the new lead agency.

We look forward to reviewing this request with you over the next few weeks and - with your support - will continue to provide for the needs of South Carolina's children and families, to the best of our resources and abilities. Prioritization	Per the Governor's Executive Order 2016-20, the lead agency for BabyNet will be transferred to the SC Department of Health and Human Services effective July 1, 2017. It is critical that these funds are appropriated to ensure that there is no change in service funding for this effort. This funding request is priority number 1 for the BabyNet system. Without these funds the number of children receiving services will have to be reduced.
